An existing NHS facility has been re-purposed to create a stunning new multi-use space at Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital (Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust).

The newly refurbished East Atrium at the hospital, based on the outskirts of Norwich features a stunning 'Big Leaves' sculpture on the walls with complementary furniture provided throughout the atrium by NHS approved provider Teal HealthCare, helping to create a flexible, modern, fit for purpose space.
